He was the ARRL Atlantic Division Technical Achievement award winner in 1998. Tim has been the moderator of the Hamvention Antenna forum for 35 years. K3LR serves as chairman of Contest University (14 years), the Dayton Contest Dinner (28 years), chairman of the Top Band Dinner – as well as coordinator of the Contest Super Suite (35 years) in Dayton during the yearly Hamvention. He is founder and moderator of the popular RFI Reflector (RFI@contesting.com) since 1999. Tim serves on the board of directors of the World Wide Radio Operators Foundation (WWROF) as Chairman and is President Emeritus of the Radio Club of America (RCA). 
